

PowerPoint Presentation: Digital Citizenship & Responsibility

Technology is changing faster than we can fathom. What do you need to know as a classroom teacher about the ethical uses of technology? What impact is technology having on our students, teachers, parents, etc.?

Your group is going to research a topic related to digital citizenship and responsibility.

- Each person in the group has to find two separate resources about the topic. Either print or the information, then read and highlight important ideas (definitions, quotes, statistics, examples, etc.) and/or take notes. Your notes or highlighted pages will be turned in for a part of the grade.
- After each group member has researched the topic you are going to discuss the information that each of you have learned about the topic and as a group develop a PowerPoint presentation to share this knowledge with your peers.
- Your presentation has to include an explanation of the issue (informative enough so that those of us that have not read about the topic, understand it), your personal experience of the issue, and your current position on the issue. Appropriate links should be imbedded in the presentation.
- Some resources you may use are Edutopia www.edutopia.org, T.H.E. Journal www.thejournal.com, Campus Technology www.campustechnology.com, Booth Library, any web browser.
- Include a resource page for all the information used in your presentation.
- Your presentation must be informative, accurate, and interesting, and engage your audience in some form.
- Each person has to participate in the presentation.
