### **Conjunction Phrases:**

**“P and Q”      $(P \wedge Q)$**

and... too	although
and yet	even though
	Sentences with relative clauses

### **Disjunction Phrases:**

**“P or Q”      $(P \vee Q)$**

or	unless
either... or	

### **More Complex Phrases:**

<b>“Neither P nor Q”</b>	<b><math>\sim(P \vee Q)</math></b>
<b>“P without Q”</b>	<b><math>(P \wedge \sim Q)</math></b>
